



Funds for 2018/19 have been spent on 3 main areas :

- Dance (KS2)

A specialist teacher has worked alongside each KS2 teacher to develop the teaching and learning in each class. Dance topics have focused on a class novel , promoting cross curricular links.

Teachers are now more confident to teach dance and movement.

Pupils made good progress, planning and performing some high quality dance routines.

- MUGA

Preparatory work for the installation of a multi-purpose all weather pitch has been completed.

This facility will provide further opportunities for quality P.E. lessons and physical activity in the wet winter months when the school field / playground is not fit for use.

- Fundamental Movement Skills (KS1)

PNE Community and Education Trust have worked alongside each KS1 teacher to develop the teaching and learning of fundamental movement skills in P.E. lessons.

Teachers have gained experience of assessing pupil standards in relation to the 10 Fundamental Movement Skills (Lancashire P.E. Scheme).

Our school is committed to improving the fundamental movement skills of all pupils. Premium funding will continue to support this vital aspect of Physical Education and the installation of a first class sports facility for our children in 2020.
