

ALL SAINTS, 1st Nov.

"Saint" is from Latin "Sanctus" = "holy". Old English said "hallowed", about holy places or things or people, especially God, "Hallowed (Holy) be thy Name".

So ALL HALLOWS means "All the Saints", and the evening before the Holyday is called Hallowe'en (= the evening of the Hallowed Ones) HALLOWE'EN is not a time to revel in evil, nor to praise evil deeds or people, but to begin celebrating that Jesus has overcome the Evil One for us, by goodness, as shown in the Holy Ones, the Saints. HAVING FUN in our religion is good. If someone dresses up as the evil one., others should dress up as saints. Saints help to protect us. The "bad guys" may try to do harm, but the "good guys" peacefully call on God's power to save us. They win the victory with Jesus. Hallowe'en is not for doing bad things; it is for having a party because we are loved and protected by God.
