


Reception Newsletter 15th October 2021



Half-term is fast approaching! This week has been exciting because we have been starting to think about some of the people who help us.

Here are just a few of the things we have done:

- The children listened to the story "Supertato" and thought about what makes a superhero. They decided that a superhero is someone who looks after others and tries to save them. They realised that we might be able to meet some real life superheroes! They have thought about who some of these people are.
- The children loved listening to our paramedic visitor and finding out about her important job helping people. The children learnt that they should call 999 for emergency help, looked at what equipment paramedics carry with them, learnt about how they protect themselves and talked about some of the things they do to help people feel better.
- The children have been learning about the numbers 1,2 and 3. They have represented these numbers in lots of ways, spotted these amounts within our school environment and compared these numbers.
- The children have learnt two new sounds this week in phonics - d and g. They have been practicing listening to the sounds in words and "chopping" words up to note the sounds.
- The children have brought home reading books for the first time this week. Please share these books regularly at home. It is great to revisit the same book multiple times so the children can get to know a story and build fluency when telling it. When reading a word encourage the children to notice each sound in the word and blend them together to read the whole word.
- The children have been recognising that they are part of God's creation too and that God knows and loves them.
- This week in PE the children have been learning different ways to use their body to roll!
- The children have been showing us their balance, teamwork and imaginative skills this week in our outdoor area by working together to build obstacle courses!
