


Reception Newsletter 12th November 2021



It has been another busy week in Reception. It was lovely to see you at parents' evening and celebrate how proud we are of the children. Thank you to the families who had the "time to talk" bags last weekend. We loved discovering what had been put inside and talking about them. Keep a look out in book bags to see if you have one this week.

Here are just a few of the things we have done:

- The children have been learning about Remembrance Day. They have considered why we have Remembrance Day, the ways we remember the soldiers who have died and the importance of peace. The children have made their own poppies and joined the whole school for our Remembrance Day worship yesterday.
- The children have been considering light and dark. They have been thinking of times when it is light and times it is dark and some of the activities we do at these times.
- The children have been consolidating what we have learnt about the numbers 1,2 and 3. They have looked at 1 and 3 sided shapes and practiced their number formation.
- The children have learnt three new sounds this week in phonics - ck, h and b. We have also been looking at some High Frequency Words (HFW) and Tricky Words and trying to read them. So far, this half term we have looked at the words "I", "and", "no", "go", "can", "on", "not", "into", "get", "got".
- This week in RE the children have been learning about the importance of kindness. They have considered kind actions and thought about some of the things they can do to be kind. They have learnt that God loves us and asked us to care for others and be kind to them.
- This week in PE we have been continuing to practice our climbing skills. The children had lots of fun on the climbing frame!

Just a reminder, please can you make sure your child's reading book is in their bag each day, especially on a Monday and Friday.
